Program In Entrepreneurship

The spirit of entrepreneurship is penetrating the university community. The Program in Entrepreneurship addresses the core set of skills and experiences necessary to cultivate the entrepreneurial mindset in U-M engineering graduates and prepares them for a changing global economy.

Core Course in Entrepreneurship: This 1-credit seminar focuses on entrepreneurship, exposing students to entrepreneurship through interactions with individuals involved in emerging business models, new venture creation, and technology commercialization.

Entrepreneurship Elective: A course from the list of Core Entrepreneurship courses or list of Elective courses available from the CFE. Each class focuses on entrepreneurship or topics such as intellectual property, innovation and/or business classes.

Entrepreneurship Practicum: This practicum focuses on entrepreneurial and hence product oriented work. The practicum is designed to gain first-hand experience in entrepreneurship by advancing an invention towards an entrepreneurial goal or by getting involved in an entrepreneurial environment.
